SPRING 2022 CONVENTION WASHINGTON, D.C.

Thursday, April 28th to Sunday, May 1st

<u>Date and Location:</u> The Spring 2022 Motor Bus Society Convention will be held from Thursday, April 28th to Sunday, May 1st in Washington, D.C. Please note that this is a four-day Thursday to Sunday convention, different from previous conventions which started on a Friday.

<u>Host Hotel:</u> The host hotel for the convention will be the Crowne Plaza – Crystal City. Located at 1480 Crystal Drive, the hotel is only a short walk from the Crystal City Metrorail station. The hotel has free high-speed WiFi internet access and a business center.

Hotel Information: The special MBS room rate is **\$136.00** (plus taxes, currently 14.25% total tax) per room per night with either two Queen beds or one King bed. A block of rooms has been put aside for MBS members from Wednesday, April 27th to Sunday, May 1st. MBS members wishing to stay outside these dates should check with the hotel to determine if the MBS group rate will be honored. The Potomac Social Tavern, Starbucks and the Veranda Café are eateries on site at the hotel with many other within a short walk or drive or Metrorail ride from the hotel. The hotel has a daily parking fee of \$20.

Please note that <u>hotel reservations must be made</u> <u>by Monday, March 28th, 2022</u>. The hotel room space and rate cannot be guaranteed after that date.

All hotel reservations must be made by either calling the hotel directly or by visiting the IHG website at www.ihg.com. Please refer to the hotel registration page (#3) for further instructions for reserving online.

The phone numbers for the hotel are (703) 416-1600 or 1-800-2CROWNE. Please see the attached "Hotel Reservation Information" form for more information and remember to mention the group name "Motor Bus Society" when booking by telephone.

Motor Bus Society is currently in the planning stages for their Spring convention. As these are not normal times, the locations shown (on page #2) are a menu of several bus company yards and public bus terminals/pulse points. There cannot be guarantees that we will be admitted to all the garages and maintenance facilities due to either COVID protocols or shortages of personnel to handle our visits. We will be visiting some of the locations on the daily itineraries; but if each location was to be available to us there would not be enough time to visit them all.

Registration: The MBS convention registration fee is \$55.00 per person per day or \$200.00 for all four days for MBS members. For non-MBS members, the registration fee is \$70.00 per day or \$260.00 for all four days. To assure that space will be available for the garage and facility tours, advance registration is strongly recommended. In case of any shortage of seat space on the tour buses, persons with reservations will be given priority. Please note that the fees are slightly more when paying by PayPal. Please refer to the convention registration page (#4) for more details.

<u>Transportation Information:</u> The Ronald Reagan Washington National Airport is only 2 miles away from the hotel. Dulles International Airport is approximately 25 miles from the hotel. The hotel is a short walk away from the Crystal City Metrorail station (Blue and Yellow lines).

<u>Convention Activities:</u> Registration and sign-in will take place in the Crowne Plaza lobby starting at 7:30 AM on all four days, with buses departing <u>promptly</u> at 8:00 AM each day.

Garage and Facility Tours: The itinerary has not been finalized and is highly dependent on whether properties are receptive to having visitors. Possible site visits are shown on the next page.


